It was one of the original colleges of the University of the Philippines and was later renamed College of Veterinary Medicine (CVM).</p> <p>Since 1996, the College maintains three academic departments, namely, Department of Basic Veterinary Sciences (DBVS), Department of Veterinary Paraclinical Sciences (DVPS), and the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences (DVCS). The Veterinary Teaching Hospital (VTH) serves as the extension arm of the College.</p> <p>CVM has been officially designated as Center of Excellence in Veterinary Medicine by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). To date, it is the only veterinary school in the country offering a Master of Science degree in Veterinary Medicine and Masters in Veterinary Epidemiology.</p>
