Office Profile Degree granting or non-degree granting Purpose of creation Location in the hierarchy (Background of the office providing the service i.e. Number of personnel and Key personnel providing the service)	The College of Veterinary Science was founded on June 18, 1908 through Act No. 1870 of the Philippine Legislature, originally in response to the urgent need for properly trained Filipino veterinarians who would combat the epidemic of rinderpest at that time. It was one of the original colleges of the University of the Philippines and was later renamed College of Veterinary Medicine (CVM).  Since 1996, the College maintains three academic departments, namely, Department of Basic Veterinary Sciences (DBVS), Department of Veterinary Paraclinical Sciences (DVPS), and the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences (DVCS). The Veterinary Teaching Hospital (VTH) serves as the extension arm of the College.  CVM has been officially designated as Center of Excellence in Veterinary Medicine by the Commission on Higher Education (CHEd). To date, it is the only veterinary school in the country offering a Master of Science degree in Veterinary Medicine and Masters in Veterinary Epidemiology.
