Objective (Description of the service being provided; History of service provision)	In response to the dynamic regulations imposed to drugs, cosmetics, and medical devices, the Department of Industrial Pharmacy added training sessions on Quality Risk Management, Risk Management Planning, and Quality Metrics. A series of lectures and workshops, this short course aims to help participants develop plans to monitor pharmaceutical systems and processes by identifying potential risks, their potential impact to products, and propose corrective and preventive actions if the need arises. These efforts will drive continuous improvements in the pharmaceutical industry, hospital and community pharmacies.
