<p>Objective (Description of the service being provided; History of service provision)</p>	<p>CTP is a non-degree training for Tertiary and Secondary Mathematics Teachers in the region. Conducted once a year, this one-week training is organized in collaboration with another higher education institution (HEI) in Northern Luzon.</p> <p>This program provides the teachers with a complete review of and/or exposure to the teaching of basic mathematics and computer science courses to help further develop the competence and confidence of the teachers in imparting the math and computer science concepts to their students. It initially aimed to upgrade the teachers' skills and knowledge in the mathematics core courses of the undergraduate programs in engineering sciences, computer science and information technology, mathematics and physics. Now, it also aims to create a good institutional relationship between the Department and the HEI in the region who is willing to host the activity.</p>
