They are also guided to assess the nutrition situation of a partner community, and to formulate a nutrition program proposal for the partner community.

<p><b>Other Remarks</b></p>	<p>Some general notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Offered every 1st semester</li> <li>- Taken by 4th year standing BSCN students</li> <li>- A copy of the program proposal is given to the partner community</li> <li>- The proposal serves as the student's final requirement</li> <li>- The service-learning courses have been implemented ever since the BSCN degree program started</li> <li>- Costs for the student's activities are covered by the lab fee of the course but if there is no lab fee (FN 170), the students shoulder the cost for transportation, meals, printing of materials, etc.</li> <li>- Sometimes LGU partners cover part of the cost of activities (venue, food, transportation, printing of materials, etc.)</li> <li>- The courses are constantly being improved by FICs handling the course by refining the guidelines for partnering with communities (LGUs and other institutions) and the evaluating and revising the course syllabus</li> </ul>
