It is a project of the Ugnayan sa Pamayanan ng CHE with Bistekville 1 community in Payatas as its beneficiary. The Unlad project aims to conduct programs "to educate and capacitate the households of the partner community through five two-day seminars led by the College. These seminars tackle the different education and training needs of the Conomics (CHE), which was conceptualized during the 2nd semester of AY 2014-2015 and was formally launched on October 29, 2015.
