Objective (Description of the service being provided; History of service provision)	This training is a capacity-building program for Local Chief Executives and Municipal Health Officers on Health Leadership and Governance, with bridging leadership as the platform for transforming health systems and improving health outcomes. This is a component of the Health Leadership and Governance Program (HCGP) of the Department of Health (DOH). It is conducted in collaboration with the Zuellig Family Foundation and other academic partners in various regions of the country. In Region 8, the School of Health Sciences is the identified academic partner that provides the training. This partnership began in 2013.

The curriculum integrates the training of the midwife, nurse and medical doctor in one sequential and continuous, community-based and competency-based curriculum. A team of nine faculty members who trained with the Zuellig Family Foundation on Bridging Leadership conducts the trainings.
