It lists seven guidelines: 1) Contact dorm managers via email/landline phone/cellphone for a schedule to avoid crowding. 2) Issue a letter to a representative (see attached Form A) to be presented to dorm personnel if unable to personally get things. 3) Both dormers or their representatives must present a Health Certificate from their Rural Health Unit or Municipal Health Office, not older than five days, when retrieving things. 4) Those who retrieve belongings in UPV dormitories shall not be allowed to stay overnight. 5) Pull-out of belongings will start on May 25 to June 22, 2020 from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. 6) When dormitories stop operations on June 23, 2020, unretrieved belongings shall be temporarily stored for safekeeping. Final retrieval of these shall resume not later than the enrollment period of the first semester, SY 2020-2021. Students who wish to have their belongings stored by UPV shall accomplish a waiver (see attached Form B). IT IS SUGGESTED THAT THE WAIVER INCLUDES UPV'S RIGHT TO DISPOSE OF THESE AFTER THE PRESCRIBED PERIOD. 7) For other concerns pertaining to the pull-out of belongings from the dormitories, please coordinate with your respective dormitory personnel. Instead call in sick and isolate self. Contact the UPHS. If test is negative, may return to work as soon as symptoms subside. If test is positive, wait for instructions. We have seen that among healthy HCWs, most symptoms are mild and fleeting. PGH will care for you in best possible way. 2) NEVER BRING your cellphones inside the COVID areas. 3) Perform HAND HYGIENE as frequently as you can on and off PGH work. 4) Change dirty outer gloves frequently between patients, especially BEFORE you enter nurses' stations and other clean areas. 5) NEVER TOUCH your face during doffing. 6) NEVER REMOVE MASK INSIDE THE COVID areas. If you feel you need to remove the mask, please proceed to the doffing area first, remove your PPEs correctly and rest in the Green Zones. 7) If your masks become soaked with sweat, pls doff your masks at the Doffing area and place in a brown paper bag with your ID card. Request for a replacement. 8) Some people feel that the coveralls/hazmat are too hot to wear and cause excessive drenching of PPE. Please note that Level 3 and Level 4 offer almost the same level of protection. If you would feel more comfortable in a disposable gown, it is okay to use this instead. 9) Eating together is okay as long as 3ft distance from one another is maintained. 10) If you live in common accommodations, space your beds 6 ft apart.
