



Established in 1991, UPLBCE is composed of students and alumni of the university, aiming to promote artistic awareness through choral music amidst a scientific community. The Ensemble's repertoire ranges from early classical works to folk ballads, popular music, and contemporary masterpieces from around the world.

The choir is currently under the baton of Roijin Galauran Suarez, a choral conducting scholar at the University of the Philippines College of Music.




