HIGHLIGHTS




- From October to December 2023, UP Baguio conducted 96 public service initiatives, which accounted for 9.98% of all recorded activities and events across the UP System.
- Knowledge exchange accounted for 47.92% of the total initiatives. Other programs in the form of student-centered, direct services, and alumniled initiatives accounted for 22.92%, while volunteer programs and community engagements accounted for 19.79%.
- October marked a notable 43.33% rise in UP Baguio's public service programs when compared to September. However, fewer initiatives were recorded in November (13.95%) and December (56.76%).

HIGHLIGHTS



- Noteworthy initiatives include the Project Wasdin-Sumya: Peer Advocacy Training Program; a roundtable discussion on the establishment of a tribal university, and the MagSILBI sa Bayan: Unveiling the DOST-UPB SILBI TBI Initiative.
- UP alumni organizations such as UP Baguio Alumni Volunteers and Friends (UPAVF) offered legal assistance to the general public; UP Medical Alumni Society in America arranged Neurographica Art Therapy to promote mental health; UPAABC initiated a scholarship program; and, in collaboration with the UP Baguio University Student Council, Sigma Delta Pi Sorority (EDT) and Sigma Kappa Pi Fraternity (EKT) Alumni Association - UP Baguio Chapter held a "Kapihan" event for students.
