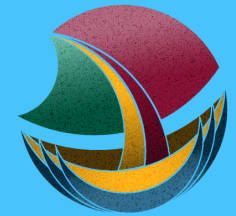

HIGHLIGHTS



- UP Manila successfully organized **199 public service initiatives**. These initiatives accounted for approximately **20.69% of all recorded activities and events across the UP System**.
- **Over 64.32% of the initiatives focused on knowledge sharing**, followed by 18.59% for alums and student-initiated events, and 11.56% of the programs involved volunteer and community engagement initiatives.
- **During October and November**, UP Manila displayed an **increased trend** in its public service endeavors, registering an **increase of 1.25% and 3.70%**, respectively. However, the number of public service initiatives recorded **dropped to 59.52% in December**.

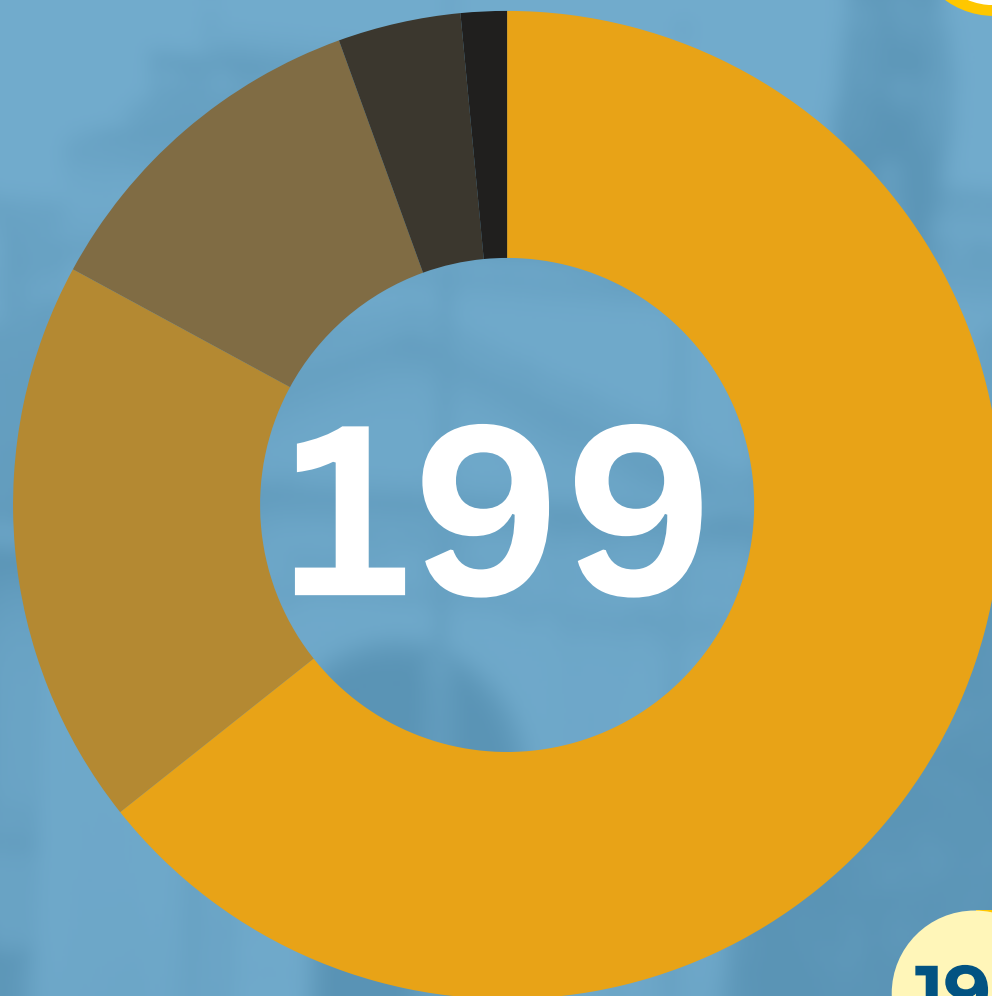
HIGHLIGHTS



- **Notable public service initiatives include:** Basic Disaster Preparedness Training for Community Health Workers, the Revisiting Family Values and Mental Health, and the Christmas Gift-Giving at Daraetan Elementary School by UP Manila Ugnayan ng Pahinungod.
- **Some alumni-related highlights include:** The UP Manila College of Medicine '98, UP Medical Alumni Association, and UP Manila College of Medicine Postgraduate Institute of Medicine partnering in the last quarter of 2023 to provide the public with several educational webinars covering various medical updates and themes.

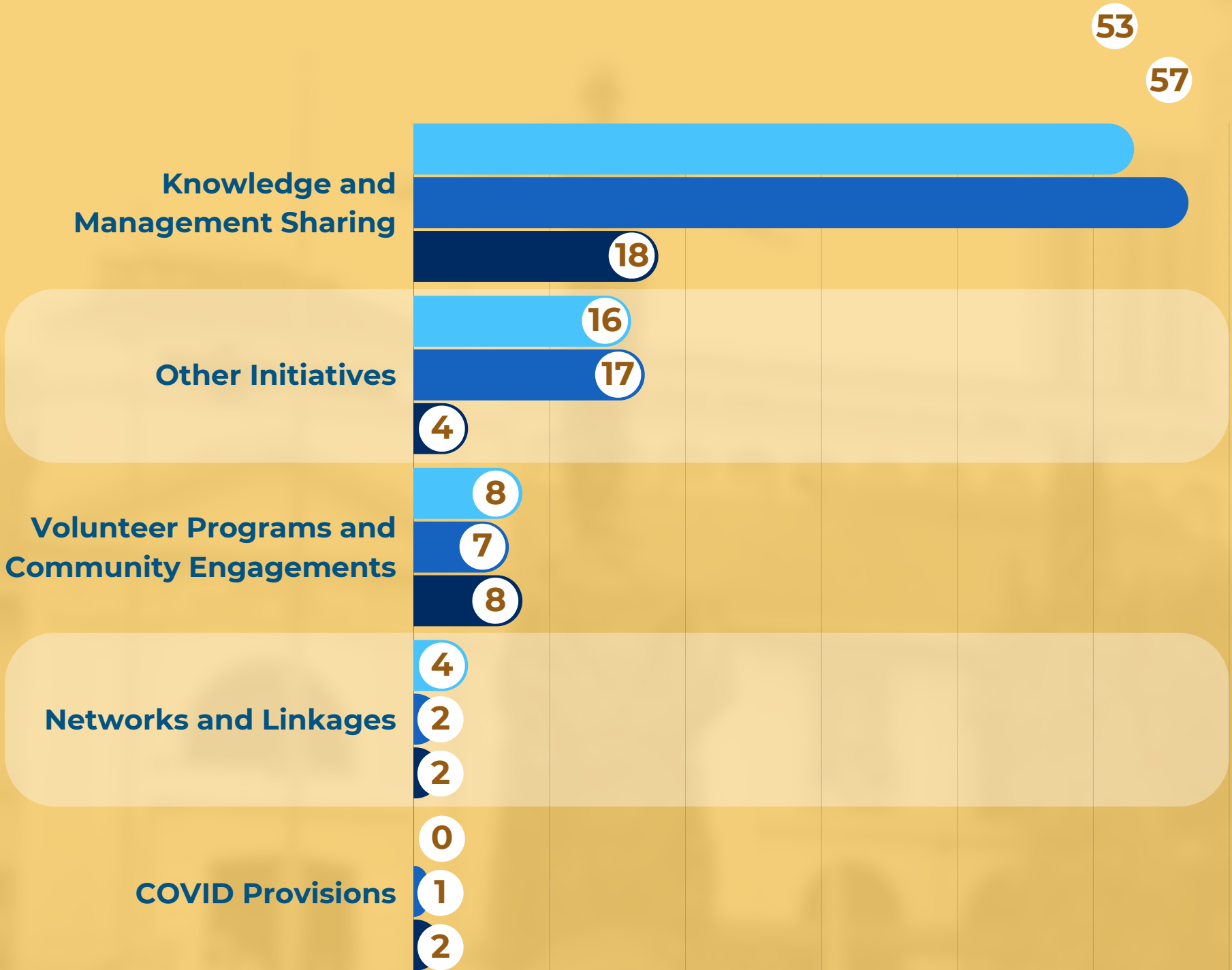
