# HIGHLIGHTS



- UP Mindanao offices and units have **facilitated 125 public service initiatives** from August to December of 2023.
- The months of **October and November has the most number** of implemented activities totaling to 34 and 33 respectively. December has the lowest number of PS with 17.
- The total public service initiatives focused on **Knowledge and Management Sharing, accounting for 79 or 63.2%** of activities from August to December. The activities under this category include, but are not limited to, knowledge-sharing activities or public events like forums, roundtable talks, seminars, webinars, etc.

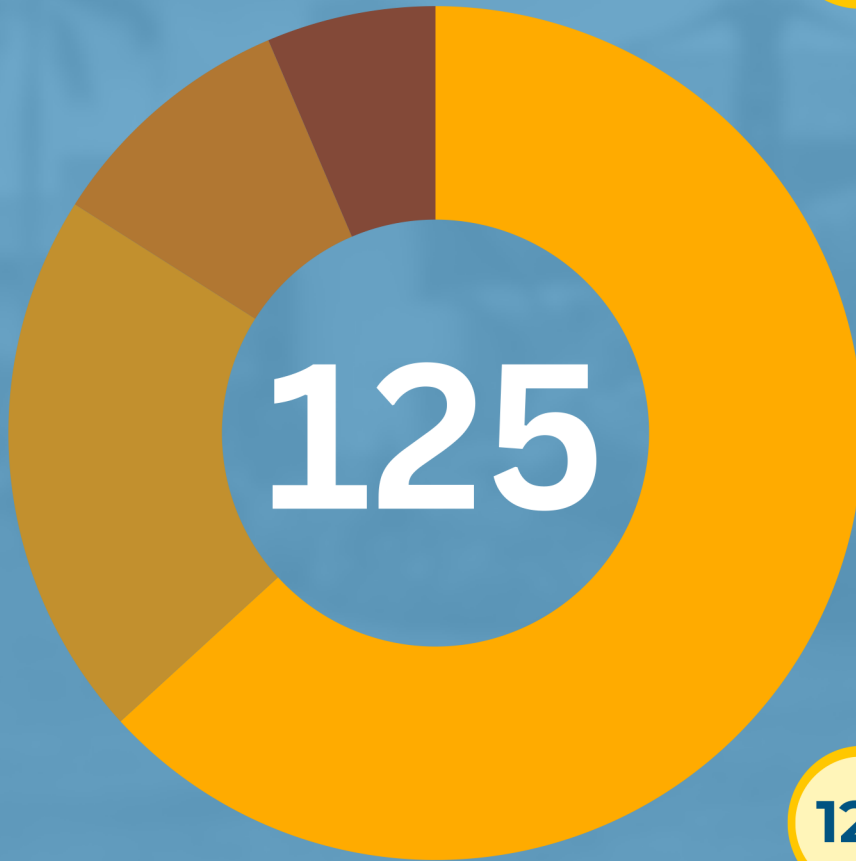
# HIGHLIGHTS



- UP Mindanao has the lowest number of reported initiatives in terms of **student-centered and alumni-led initiatives, with only 6.4%** of its total initiatives from August to December.
- UP Mindanao ranked 6th based on the reported number of implemented public service initiatives from August to December. **Their reported PS activities comprise 8.2% of the total public service initiatives of UP.**
- A notable public service initiative of UP Mindanao for this reporting period was the **installation of its new dormitory** that will house 232 students and multipurpose facilities for enhanced living and learning services. The new dorm has 60 rooms for students, four students in each room; two rooms for PWDs, two guest rooms, and eight offices.

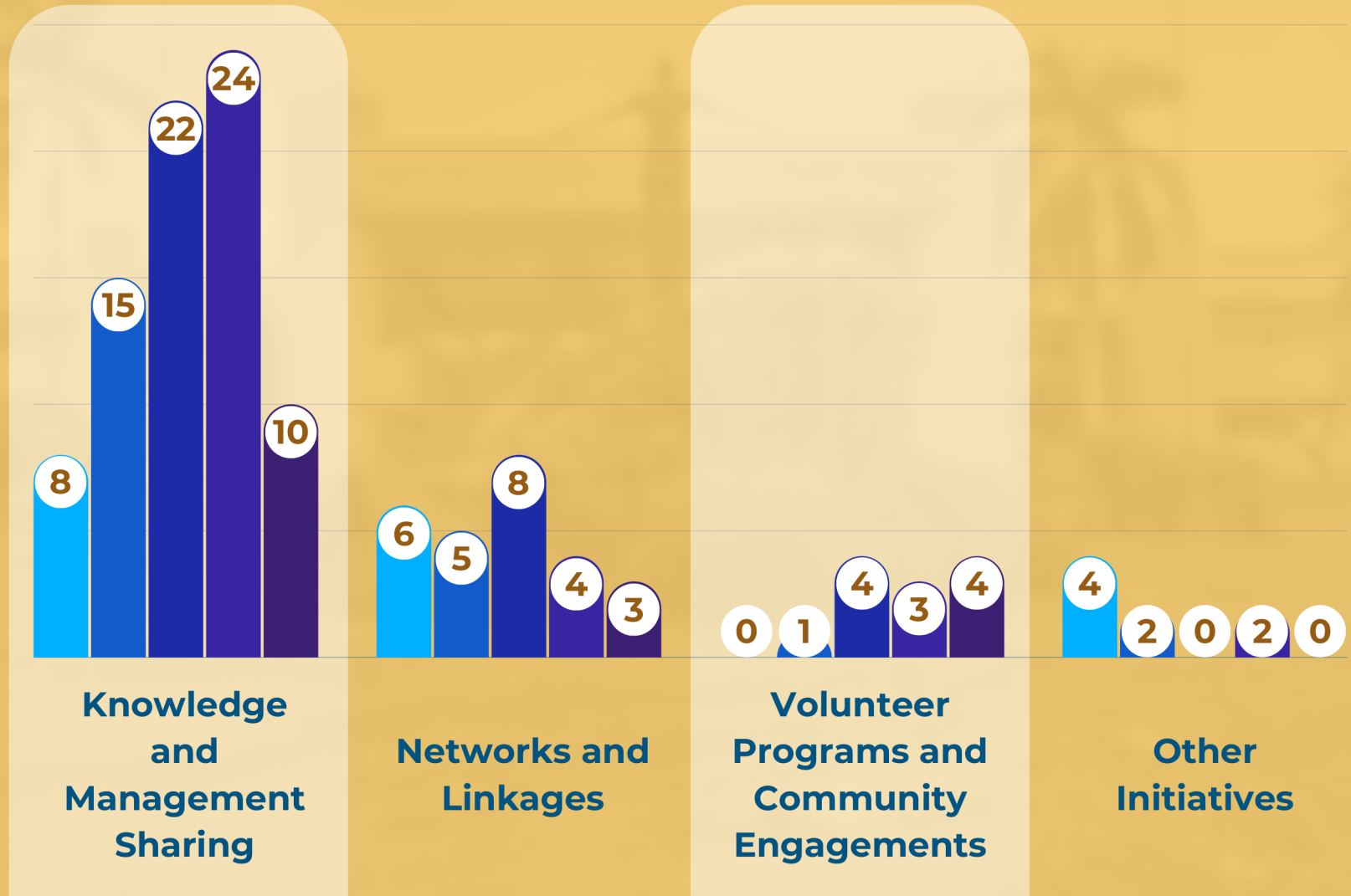

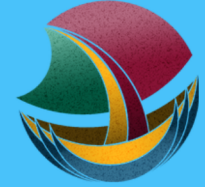
# COMPARISON OF UP MINDANAO PUBLIC SERVICE PROJECTS: AUGUST - DECEMBER 2023

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# RECOMMENDATIONS



- To enable efficient tracking and collection of public service data based on their online postings, **UP Mindanao can start implementing a labeling system for its public service initiatives, which may involve designated hashtags such as #PadayonPSReport and #UPMindanaoPublicService.**
- UP Mindanao is encouraged to sustain the high number of initiatives under Knowledge and Management Sharing, but should also **focus on the diverse range of public service initiatives such as those initiated by students and alumni.**
- Given the reported low number of public service initiatives under Volunteer Programs and Community Engagements, UP Mindanao can partner with the Padayon Public Service Office in terms of reporting and disseminating its volunteer and community engagement activities.

# RECOMMENDATIONS



- UP Mindanao can also encourage its units and offices to facilitate initiatives led by its students and/or those that will directly benefit the students. **They can also explore and boost partnerships and engagement with UP Mindanao Alumni to increase the impact of its public service initiatives.**
- UP Mindanao can initiate an **assessment and evaluation of the October and November strategies** to identify the best practices, and thus replicate this for consistent public service engagements.
- For monitoring and reporting purposes, UP Mindanao may explore including in their post the type of beneficiary of each public service initiative, the intervention reach or number of participants reached, and **if possible the tagging of sustainable development goals, to gauge the strategic impact reach of each public service initiative.**
