


- UP Cebu's total public service initiatives for the second quarter of 2025 were 62, indicating an 8% increase from the first quarter of the year.
- Direct Service Provision (40%) stood out among the public service initiatives, followed by Information Dissemination (37%), and Service to University (13%).
- The public service initiatives of UP Cebu made the greatest impact on Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) #4 Quality Education (46), followed by SDG #10 Reduced Inequalities (11) and SDG #17 Partnerships for the Goals (9).



Notable public service initiatives from UP Cebu included the Leadership
Training-Workshop on Parliamentary Procedures and Conflict
Resolution at Subangdaku Technical Vocational School, designed to
equip Supreme Student Government officers with essential skills for
effective leadership and conflict resolution, and the Free Action Research
Coaching: Planning the Topic and Methodology for partner schools. Both
initiatives were organized by UP Cebu Ugnayan ng Pahinungód.






- UP Diliman (UPD) conducted 375 public service (PS) initiatives for the 1st quarter of 2025. This is an 86% increase compared to the same quarter last year.
- The majority of UPD's PS initiatives, around 57% in the quarter, fell under Information Dissemination. This was followed by Service to University with 29%, and Technical Assistance & Consultancy with 5%.
- Notable Initiative: Students from the UPD College of Engineering Electrical and Electronics Engineering Institute designed an electricpowered propulsion system for bangkas, the country's traditional rural fishing boats.



- **Alumni-led:** The UP Gamma Sigma Pi Fraternity Alumni Association, Inc. signed a supplemental MOA with UPD for the expansion of their scholarship program for UP students.
- Majority of UP Diliman's PS initiatives for the period fell under SDG 4 (Quality Education), with 316 initiatives. This was followed by SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being) with 69 initiatives, and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals) with 50 initiatives.





UP LOS BAÑOS

April - June 2025

- UP Los Baños carried out 395 public service initiatives in the second quarter of 2025, marking a 58% increase from the first quarter of the same year.
- Information Dissemination (31%) stood out among the public service initiatives, followed by Service to University (25%), and Direct Service Provision (23%).
- The majority (168) of UP Los Baños' public service initiatives
 contributed to Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) #4 Quality
 Education, while 71 supported SDG #11 Sustainable Cities and
 Communities, and 64 supported SDG #17 Partnerships for the Goals.



Notable public service initiatives from UP Los Baños this quarter include the DUNONG Program, a partnership with DepEd-Laguna aimed at addressing learning poverty—where up to 9 in 10 ten-year-olds struggle to read. The program features three key components: Reading Enhancement and Appreciation Development (READ), Nutri-Nurture (promoting proper nutrition), and TEACH-OA (teacher training in organic agriculture). The launch was attended by DepEd Secretary Sonny Angara and leaders from private industry and NGOs.


